DTI Announces Release of Office To-Go and Enhancements to Office Therapy

HAGERSTOWN, MD, November 5, 2002 - DocuTrac, Incorporated (DTI) developers of behavioral health software, announced today the release of Office To-Go™ (OTG) for Palm™ and Palm-compatible handheld devices. OTG was designed for use with Office Therapy™, DTI's billing program which was acquired earlier this year from MBC Systems, Inc.

OTG synchronizes the Office Therapy Calendar and contact information for clients, referral sources, and insurance companies between a Palm handheld and a PC. OTG allows users to review and update important information, to schedule appointments and events, and enter appointment notes while away from their PC.

"Since acquiring Office Therapy, DTI has been improving and enhancing the product. Development of OTG indicates the company's commitment to Office Therapy users," says Darrell Singleton, lead developer of OTG. According to Mr. Singleton, DTI plans to integrate Office Therapy with the Standard Edition of their QuicDoc® Clinical Documentation System. He says that by combining both technologies in a single program, DTI will be able to offer a seamless front to back office system for solo and small group practices.

DTI president Arnold Schuster, Ph.D. commented that "integrating the two programs enables DTI to offer their behavioral healthcare customers one solid program that will have the best of both technologies for billing and documentation." DTI will integrate Office Therapy and QuicDoc in phases. The first phase, an automatic import and edit of demographic information between the two systems, is nearly completed.

Dr. Schuster goes on to say, "even though the two programs will ultimately be seamlessly integrated, DTI will still continue to maintain both QuicDoc and Office Therapy as separate programs. As a matter of fact a Palm application for QuicDoc is currently in development."

Recent enhancements for Office Therapy include a new day sheet, enhanced Help using compiled HTML format, and changes to allow partnering with clearinghouses to ensure HIPAA compliance for electronic claims transmission.
